

**RESOLUTION 2020-32**

**A RESOLUTION AMENDING, WASTEWATER FEES, EFFECTIVE OCTOBER 1, 2020**

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEWISTON, IDAHO:**

SECTION 1: Wastewater fees shall be as follows:

(1) Wastewater service, per month:

SECTION 2: All fees established by this resolution shall remain in effect until modified by resolution of the City Council.

SECTION 3: Upon the effective date of this resolution, this resolution shall supersede Resolution 2019-39 in its entirety.

SECTION 4: This resolution shall take effect on October 1, 2020.


